

# OpenBSD Firewall Config Cheatsheet

## Partitions:

a, 500m, /  
b, 2x ram, swap  
d, 800m, tmp  
e, 1g, /var  
f, 8g, /usr  
g, all the rest, /home

## Sets:

base3x.tgz  
etc3x.tgz  
man3x.tgz  
bsd

## Create user:

adduser  
Take defaults for config of adduser  
Take default options for creating user  
/etc/group – add user into wheel

## Config:

Turn off Sendmail  
rc.conf - sendmail\_flags=NO  
crontab – crontab –e, comment out \*/30 \* \* \* \* /usr/bin/sendmail -L

/etc/sysctl.conf  
Uncomment net.inet.ip.forwarding=1

/etc/rc.conf  
pf = YES

ifconfig <nic2> delete  
ifconfig <nic3> delete  
(leave nic0 as remote access)  
ifconfig <nic2> up  
ifconfig <nic3> up

***Note: the following command may not work, but if it doesn't, skip and move on to setting the bridge up permanently below, and reboot.***

brconfig bridge0 add nic2 add nic3 up

/etc/hostname.nic2

up

/etc/hostname.nic3

up

/etc/bridgename.bridge0

add nic2 add nic3 up
